I am pleased to inform you that the European Society of Hypertension organizes this year's Summer School in Smolenice (near Bratislava), Slovakia, September 19-25, 2009.

The financial rules will be the same as last year:

- 1) The attendees' accommodation and meals will be covered by the ESH.
- 2) The attendees' travel costs should be covered by the national societies of hypertension.
- 3) The ESH will pay the accommodation and travel costs of the faculty.

There will still be some travel grants provided by the ESH for countries facing economic hardship.

We would appreciate at least two candidates from each country; bigger countries may send more than two applications (with each national society of hypertension being financially responsible for their attendees). Please note the ESH Summer School is only a **once-in-a-lifetime event**, which means each participant can attend the course only once in his/her life. Although there is no specific age limit, **younger candidates** strongly **devoted to hypertension** should be **preferred**.

Each national society of hypertension will be informed about the selection of candidates in early June 2009.
